How we use your information:

Our legal reason for using the data is that you have given us your **consent** by providing your contact details. Our additional lawful basis for processing this information is your **explicit consent** if you choose to share sensitive personal data with us as part of your submitted enquiry. You have the right to withdraw your consent in relation to this processing by using the contact email address above.

If you share health data with us to request reasonable adjustments or equality of access, for example prior to visiting our campus, then our lawful basis for processing this data is for **reasons of substantial public interest** to *promote equality of opportunity or treatment*, referring to the Equalities Act 2010 as a basis in law.

Our lawful basis for processing is to comply with a **legal obligation** to respond and satisfy requests received under the following legislation:

- Environmental Information (Scotland) Regulations 2004
- Scottish Public Services Ombudsman Act 2002

Withholding personal information

Retention:

Your data will be retained in accordance with the UHI NWH Records Retention and Disposal Policy, which follows the UHI Retention and Disposal Policy. If ID has been requested, only a record that your identity has been verified will be retained and copies will be securely destroyed.

Your data subject rights:

- The right to access your personal data
- The right to rectification if the personal data we hold about you is incorrect
- The right to restrict processing of your personal data
- The right to withdraw explicit consent, specifically in relation to the processing of your special category data contained in a DSAR, FOISA request or complaint.
